To raise the English proficiency and self-confidence of Hong Kong's young people, particularly the less privileged, through dynamic interaction with English-speaking university graduates working in creative partnership with schools.



The Need for English in Hong Kong

Why do we do what we do?



In 2019 **47%** of students did not achieve the minimum English grades to enter university.

Only about **7%** of students from families below the poverty line ever attend university, often due to low English exam results.

Without English students are held back from educational, professional and personal progression.

Your Role

You will be placed in a local Hong Kong school full time to work alongside the local English teaching staff. Your role will be to plan and deliver lessons as well as interactive workshops, tutorials and events outside of the classroom.



Our Programmes

We currently offer two programmes working with Primary school students aged 5-11 or Secondary school students aged 12-18.

We do not require any prior teaching experience, just a desire and passion to help young minds.

Orientation and Training

At the start of your programme you will undergo a three week training programme to get you feeling confident and prepared for your first day in the classroom. You will receive additional training every month and additional support from a dedicated Programme Manager.

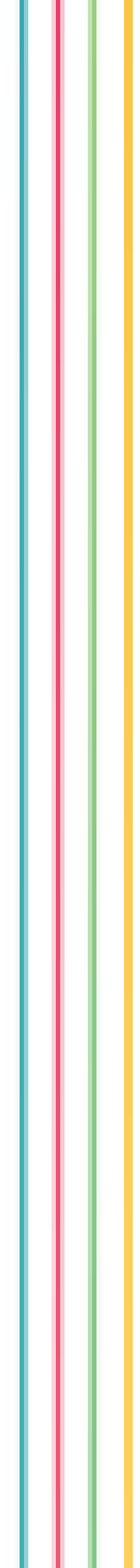
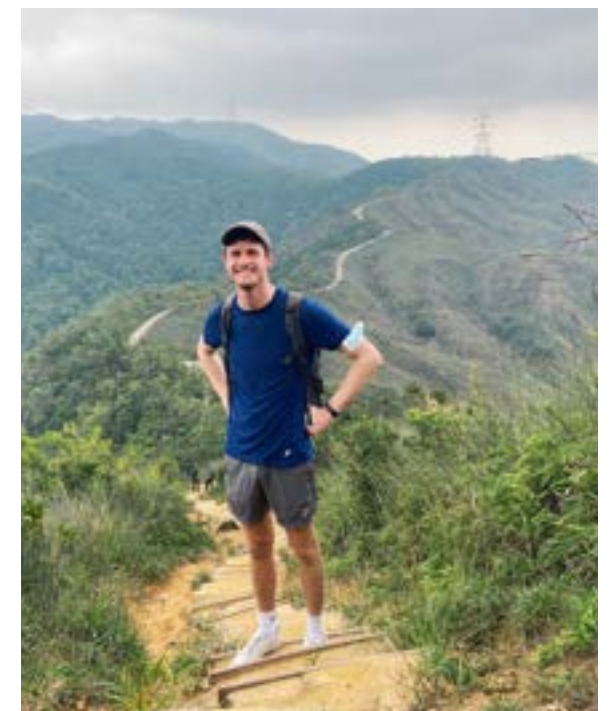
